



Facility & Property Rental

In her deed of gift donating Brucemore to the National Trust for Historic Preservation, Margaret Douglas Hall stipulated that private, religious, or political events may not be held at Brucemore. Brucemore can host non-profit organizations and corporate members for facility and property rentals for purposes directly related to the renting organization's mission.

The following has been compiled to help you determine whether Brucemore fits your rental needs. Individual event prices may vary depending on event needs. Below are base rental fees which are subject to change. Supplementary services can be arranged for an additional fee and final costs are assessed following each event.

Meeting Spaces

Availability: Monday-Friday, 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM. Weekend and evening use may be arranged at the discretion of staff.

Cost: \$50 per hour or part thereof. During the holiday season (Thanksgiving-January7) peak pricing of \$75 per hour is in effect.

Space	Capacity	Description
Hall-Perrine Suite	10 (seated)	Located on the second floor of the Queen Anne mansion, the suite features a board room and sitting room with view of the formal garden. <i>Note: This space is only accessible by stair.</i>
Visitor Center Meeting Room	15 (seated at tables) 30 (lecture seating)	Located in the historic carriage house near Brucemore's free permanent exhibit, this space offers amenities including Wifi, projector screen, accessible bathrooms and convenient parking.
Bookbindery Meeting Room	12 (seated)	This space features a board room with excellent views of the Servants' Village and is located within a building that is typically not accessible to the public.

Event Spaces

Availability: Monday & Tuesday, 8:00 AM – 10:00 PM. Wednesday- Sunday, after 4:30 PM. Additional use may be arranged at the discretion of staff and dependent on availability.

Cost: Rental costs are determined based on the length of the event and the number of guests. Brucemore offers one free hour for set-up and one free hour for clean-up for any event lasting more than two hours. The price per hour (or part thereof) for single space and multi-space events are listed below. During the holiday season (Thanksgiving-January 7) peak pricing is in effect.

Space	Capacity	Description
Great Hall	40 (seated) 75 (standing)	The Great Hall is a beautiful space, designed for elegant entertaining and located within the historic mansion.
Visitor Center	40 (seated) 60 (standing)	Located in the historic and charming 1912 carriage house, the Visitor Center transforms from an exhibit space into an event space.
Courtyard	225 (seated) 350 (standing)	This outdoor space is located by the charming 1912 carriage house. This sunlit space is nestled within the historic servants' village at Brucemore.
First Avenue Lawn	Unlimited	This expansive space is framed by the historic, Queen-Anne mansion. The space has accommodated more than 20,000 visitors.
Pool Yard*	150 (seated) 250 (standing)	* The pool yard is unavailable in 2019 due to on-going preservation work in that area. Located beside the mansion, the pool yard is an excellent location for relaxed summer events.
West Lawn	200 (seated) 400 (standing)	Nestled among shade trees and situated beside Brucemore's historic mansion, the west lawn is the ideal location for a summer event.
