

FACILITY AND PROPERTY RENTAL

Preferred vendors have been pre-selected and trained on the unique requirements; other vendors may be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. MEETING SPACES

To be eligible: Must be a Corporate Member at a minimum level of \$250 annually or a non-profit organization.

Availability: Monday-Friday, 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM. Weekend and evening use may be arranged at the discretion of staff and may be subject to additional fees.

Cost: \$50 per hour or part thereof with add-ons available. Peak pricing of \$75 per hour or part thereof during the holiday season (November to January). All meeting rentals include the option for a 20-minute introduction to Brucemore presentation. A standard guided tour *or* presentation of up to 60 minutes on a topic of staff expertise may be added for \$50.

SPACE	CAPACITY	DESCRIPTION
Hall-Perrine Suite	10 (seated)	Located on the second floor of the Queen Anne mansion, the suite features a boardroom and sitting room with view of the formal garden. <i>Note: This space is only accessible by stair and does not offer WiFi.</i>
Carriage House Meeting Room	15 (seated at tables) 30 (lecture seating)	Located in the historic carriage house near Brucemore's free permanent exhibit, this space offers amenities including Wifi, projector and screen, accessible bathrooms, and convenient parking.
Bookbindery Meeting Room	12 (seated)	This space features a large table with view of the Servants' Village and is located within a building that is typically not open to the public. This building includes a second-floor restroom with accessible restrooms located in a nearby building. <i>Note: This space does not include WiFi.</i>

EVENT SPACES

To be eligible: Must be a Corporate Member at a minimum level of \$500 annually or a non-profit organization.

Availability: Inquire about availability based on space, capacity, and type of event.

Cost: Based on the length of the event, number of guests, event requirements, and add-ons. The price per hour (or part thereof) for single-space and multi-space events are listed below. Events require a two-hour minimum and include one free hour for set-up and one free hour for clean-up. Peak pricing is in effect during the holiday season, November through January.

Mansion First Floor	40 (seated) 75 (standing)	The first floor Great Hall and adjoining rooms offer a beautiful setting, designed for elegant entertaining located within the historic mansion. <i>*Self-guided tour access to other floors may be added for \$25 an hour.</i>
Carriage House	40 (seated) 60 (standing)	Located in the historic and charming 1912 carriage house, the Visitor Center transforms from an exhibit space into an event space.
Courtyard	225 (seated) 350 (standing)	This outdoor space is located by the charming 1912 carriage house. This sunlit space is nestled within the historic servants' village at Bruce more.
First Avenue Lawn	Unlimited	This expansive space is framed by the historic, Queen-Anne mansion. The space has accommodated more than 20,000 visitors.
West Lawn	200 (seated) 400 (standing)	Nestled on the west side of the historic mansion, the west lawn makes a great location for outdoor cocktail parties.
